## Des Moines Services

#### Services for People with Disabilities

In both the home and community, we help people with disabilities build life skills for independence, such as cooking, budgeting and social interaction. Our trained respite care providers offer relief for family caregivers.

- Helps people live with dignity on their own, rather than in a state facility
- Supports people in achieving their goals

#### **Adoption and Foster Care**

As a partner agency of Iowa KidsNet, LSI helps find and support safe foster and adoptive (from foster care) homes for Iowa children.

• Creates permanency for children through reunification or adoption

#### Therapy and Behavioral Health Intervention

LSI's licensed therapists provide a range of therapy and counseling services that can include play therapy for children and therapy for adults and teens.

If a child has a behavioral or mental health diagnosis and receives Medicaid Title 19, our behavioral health services can help him or her build skills such as anger management, positive decision-making and coping.

#### Parent Education and Support

Our in-home visitation programs help parents of children ages four and under build on their strengths and learn strategies for parenting in areas such as positive discipline, parent-child interaction, and healthy development.

#### First Circle Friends

This group respite program provides renewal, friendship and support for people with memory loss and their family caregivers.

#### **Refugee Community Services**

LSI provides services to people of refugee status to help them adapt and thrive in their new home. Programs include elder outreach, intensive work readiness courses, English as a Second Language classes, child care development, Global Greens agriculture programs and resource connections with refugee community representatives.
